Fall-ing for colourful leaves

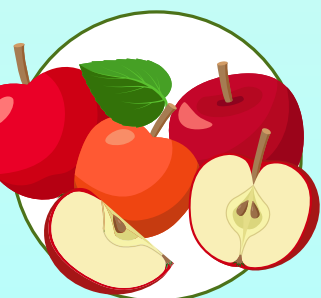

Pumpkin spice and everything nice

In 2022, Ontario had the largest area (**9,431 acres**) of Canada's total pumpkin harvested area (**12,338 acres**). This represents more than three-quarters (**76.4%**) of the pumpkin area harvested in the country.
