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#### **Notes**

- 1. The **operator** of the shipping line is the enterprise that **controls** the operation and movement of the equipment. The operator is usually responsible for supplying a crew; maintaining equipment in proper worker order; and deciding when, and to which location, equipment will be moved. **The country of residence of the operator is, in other words, where the operations are centered**. This location may be different from the flag registration of the vessel operated or it could differ from the country of residence of the ship owner.
- 2. The other **European Union** countries includes: Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Hungary, Ireland, Italy, Latvia, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden and since 2013, Croatia.
- Other OECD countries include: Australia, Chile, Iceland, Israel, Liechtenstein, New Zealand, Switzerland and Turkey.
