Statistics Canada will only share data from this survey with those organizations that have demonstrated a requirement to use the data.

Section 11 of the *Statistics Act* provides for the sharing of information with provincial and territor statistical agencies that meet certain conditions. These agencies must have the legislative authomy to collect the same information, on a manuatory basis, and the legislation must provide substatially the same provisions for confidentiality and penaline for disclosure of confidential information on the *Statistics Act*. Because these agencies have the legislation authority to compel businesses to provide the same information, consent is not requested and businesses may not object to the sharing of the data.
