CONFIDENTIALITY

Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from publishing any statistics which would divulge information obtained in a gregate form only. The confidentiality provisions of the Statistics Act are not affected by either the Access to Information Act or any other legislation. An except in to the general rule of confidentiality under the Statistics Act is the disclosure, at the discretion of the Chief Statistician, of identifiable information relating to the public utilities, which includes undertakings supplying petroleum or petroleum products by pipeline, and undertakings supplying, transmitting or distributing gas pledicity reseam. This applies to the dissemination of survey results at the dissemination of technical information for utilities at the location level.

DATA SHARING AGREEMENTS

To reduce response burden and to ensure uniform statistics, Statistics Canada has en, red into data sharing agreements with various agencies and government departments for the joint collection and sharing of data from this survey.

Agreements exist under section 11 of the Statistics Act to share information with use statistical agencies of Nova Scotia, Québec, Saskatchewan and Alberta regarding business establishments located or operating in their respective province. These provincial statistical agencies have been established under provincial legislation authorizing them to collect this information on their own or jointly's Statistics Canada. The provincial legislation in those four provinces also contains the same confidentiality protection and outlines similar penalties for disclosure of confidential information as the federal Statistics Act.

Agreements exist under Section 12 of the Statistics Act with Natural Resources Canada, the National Energy Board, Environment Canada and the British Columbia Ministry of Energy, Mines and Petroleum Resources.
