

Confidentiality

Data-sharing agreements

Statistics Canada will only share data from this survey with those organizations that have demonstrated a requirement to use the data.

Under **Section 12** of the *Statistics Act*, respondents can object to the sharing of information with other organizations. Transport Canada has the legislative authority to collect and use this information pursuant to the *Canada Transportation Act* (CTA) and the *Transportation Information Regulations*.
