

General information

Confidentiality

For the Capital and Repair Expenditures Survey, The Chief Statistician has authorized the release of data relating to carriers, public utilities and non-commercial institutions including, but not limited to, hospitals, libraries, educational institutions, federal government entities and individual provincial, territorial and municipal governments. These include capital and repair expenditure expenditures at the aggregate level.

Data-sharing agreements

To reduce respondent burden, Statistics Canada has entered into data-sharing agreements with provincial and territorial statistic agencies and other government organizations, which have a reed to keep the data confidential and use then only for statistical purposes. Statistics Canada will only share data from this survey with more conanizations that have demonstrated a regular to use the dat

Section 11 of the chaistics Act provides for the sharing of information with provincial and tentroric's statistical at encies that meet certain conditions. These acencies must have the legislative authority to collect the same information on a manuatory basis, and the legislation must provide substantially the same provisions for confidentiality and penalties for ciscloture of confidential information as the

Statistics Act. Because these agencies have the legal authority to compel businesses to provide the same information, consent is not requested and businesses may not object to the sharing of the data.

For this survey, there are **Section 1** agreements with the provincial and territorial stat stical agencies of Newfoundland and Labrador Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Quebec Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, Braish Columbia and the Yukon. The shared data will be mited to information pertaining to business establishments located within the jurisdiction of the respective province or territory.
