# GENERAL INFORMATION

## Confidentiality

#### Your answers are confidential.

Statistics Canada is prohibited by law from releasing any information it collects which could identify any person, business or organization, unless consent has been given by the respondent or as permitted by the *Statistics Act*. The confidentiality provise of the *Statistics Act* are not affected by either the *Access to Information Act* or any other legislation. Therefore, for example, the Canac Revenue Agency cannot access identifiable survey records from Statistics Canada.

## **Record linkages**

To enhance the data from this survey, Statistics Canada may combine it with information from other surveys or from administrative sources.

## **Data-sharing agreements**

To avoid duplication of enquiry, Statistics Canada has entered into data-sharing agreements with provincial statistical agencies, which must keep the data confidential and use them only for statistical purposes. Statistic Canada will only share data from this survey with those organizations that have demonstrated a requirement to use the data.

Section 11 of the *Statistics Act* provides for the sharing of information with rovincial statistical agencies that meet certain conditions.
