CHILDREN AND YOUTH: A HEALTH PRIORITY

The COVID-19 pandemic has highlighted the need for up-to-date data on childhood immunization coverage. Developing policies and programs to ensure children are protected against disease requires a complete picture of the factors that influence parental decisions about immunization.

YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE

The information collected by the Childhood National Immunization Coverage Survey (CNICS) will allow us to measure the immunization status of children across Canada, and will provide insight into parental knowledge of vaccines and the diseases they prevent.

Your participation in this survey will help policy-makers to determine where improvements are needed for prenatal, childhood, and youth immunization programs and services.

Parents and guardians will be asked about:

- Vaccines their child has received
- Immunization knowledge & choices

Mothers of infants will be asked about:

- Vaccines they received while pregnant
- Knowledge of pre-natal vaccination and childhood immunization
